

Tiger Reads Summer Program



Campus School is offering a special summer reading program for its students. All students in grades 2-6 will have the opportunity to participate in the program. Classroom teachers are encouraging students to read Accelerated Reader(AR) books and books from the recommended summer reading list. After reading the selections, your child will have the opportunity to come to school during the summer to take the AR Comprehension test on the books he/she has read. Points for those tests will accrue during the summer.

Prizes will be given to a student from each grade level who acquires the most points. In addition, all students who earn 20 AR points during the summer reading program will become members of the Tiger Reading Hall of Fame. As exclusive Hall of Fame members, students will receive a goodie bag, Tiger Reading Hall of Fame t-shirt and tickets to a University of Memphis football game, compliments of The U of M Athletic Department.

Your child must be registered to participate in the program. Registration is open June 23-July 6. You may register at the Campus School Office from 8:00-3:30 or fax the registration form to 678-4235.

To help you get started in this program, a copy of the STAR reading report was sent home at the end of the year that included the recreational reading level of child. This information is helpful when selecting appropriate reading materials.

Campus School will be open the following dates for testing. Students will also be allowed to take tests the first two weeks of school. Program ends August 14.
